ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR (Regular Full-Time)

The Community Development Department – Inspections Division requires a regular full-time Electrical Inspector.

You will inspect residential, commercial and industrial electrical installations and equipment at various stages of completion, and review related plans to ensure compliance with applicable by-laws, electrical codes, Acts, standards and regulations. In addition, you will check plans and specifications in order to issue permits; provide technical advice, assistance, and information to a variety of internal and external contacts; prepare and present evidence in court, as required; and perform investigations related to fires and electrical accidents as required.

You will possess a B.C. Electrical Trades Qualification, a valid class 5 BC Drivers License and must be qualified or eligible to become qualified as a Safety Officer in accordance with the BC Safety Standards Act General Regulation, which requires a minimum of 5 years in the electrical trade. A valid Class “A” - B.C. Journeyman’s Certificate would be an asset. Proven experience interacting with the public in a diplomatic and tactful manner, as well as superior oral and written communication skills, are also required.

The successful applicant will be required to provide their own transportation in return for reimbursement according to the Vehicle Policy.

Hours of Work:

The City of North Vancouver currently works on a compressed work schedule, Monday to Friday, with one scheduled day off (Monday or Friday) approximately each three-week scheduling cycle. Hours of work are on a rotational basis of two shifts (either 7:30a.m. to 4:00p.m. or 8:30a.m to 5:00p.m. respectively).
